

Average Raw Residuals by Subject - Based on results received nationally by CEM

The graph below shows residual values by subject as published by the Centre for Evaluation and Monitoring (CEM). The bars of the graph are expressed in terms of fractions of a GCSE grade. A positive score of 1.0 for example means that, on average, pupils at Manor House gained 1 GCSE grade higher in a subject than pupils of a similar ability in other schools nationally.
